





## **Alternative Concepts (phase 2)**




Posted Speed Limit: 40-50 MPH ADT: 46,000 (at Fair Oaks Blvd) - 59,000 (at WB US 50 ramps)








### **Community Preferred Alternative: 2**










#### **Preferred Alternative: 2**

- Adding a shared-use path on the east side of Howe Avenue.
- Adding a landscaping buffer with shade trees and lighting on the east side of Howe Avenue.
- Filling sidewalks gaps.
- Lowering the posted speed limits.
- Adding a shared use path through University Park and an enhanced crossing on University Avenue.
- Adding signalized crosswalks at US 50 ramp crossings on both sides of Howe Avenue.
- Adding a cantilever bridge on the east side of the American River Bridge and the US 50 overpass






#### **Preferred Alternative continued**

In response to community input during phase 2, the plan will also include:

• Removing a travel lane in each direction between American River Drive and the American River Bridge



 Further analysis on additional lane reduction and tightening of intersection at College Town Dr at the Freeway off-ramp, including study of College Town Dr and La Riviera Dr

- Adding Speed diverters north of the University Ave/ American River overpass
- Adding optical speed bars where appropriate along the corridor


