***NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC**

It is the policy of the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Regional Transit District to encourage participation in the meetings of the Board of Directors. At each open meeting, members of the public will be provided with an opportunity to directly address the Board on items of interest to the public that are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board of Directors. Please fill out a speaker card and give it to the Board Clerk if you wish to address the Board. Speaker cards are provided on the table at the back of the auditorium. If you are participating virtually, you will be asked to raise your hand at the time the item is called. If you are participating by telephone, you will be prompted to indicate your interest in speaking on an item at the time the item you wish to speak on is called by the Board Clerk. If you desire to participate by two-way telephonic you must call 669-444-9171 and enter Webinar ID 885 6475 0782. If you are participating by audiovisual virtual access, join the Zoom Webinar at <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/88564750782>.

Public comment may be given on any agenda item as it is called and will be limited by the Chair for all participants including those in person, on the telephone or on a virtual platform, to 2 minutes or less per speaker. The Consent Calendar, the General Manager's Report and Reports, Ideas and Questions from Directors, and Communication will each be treated and taken up as one unit and individuals wishing to comment on any of these items will be able to speak for up to 2 minutes per unit. Speakers wishing to comment on any other agenda items will be provided 2 minutes for each item listed on the Agenda. Speakers using a translator will be provided twice the allotted time, to account for the time needed to translate speaker's comment. When it appears there are several members of the public wishing to address the Board on a specific item, at the outset of the item the Chair of the Board will announce the maximum amount of time that will be allowed for public comment on that item.

Written public comment submitted to boardcomments@sacrt.com up to 250 words and received by 1:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting will be provided to the Board and will become part of public record upon submission to the Board.

Matters under the jurisdiction of the Board and not on the posted agenda may be addressed under the Item "Public addresses the Board on matters not on the agenda." Up to 30 minutes will be allotted for this purpose. The Board limits public comment on matters not on the agenda to 2 minutes or less per person and not more than 15 minutes for a particular subject. If public comment has reached the 30-minute time limit, and not all public comment has been received, public comment will resume after other business has been conducted as set forth on the agenda. The Chair, in their discretion may allow for public comment to continue beyond the 30-minute time limit. The Board will not act upon or discuss an item that is not listed on the agenda except as provided in Section 3.1.3.6.

This agenda may be amended up to 72 hours prior to the meeting being held. An agenda, in final form, is posted by the front door of Sacramento Regional Transit's building located at 1102 Q Street, Sacramento, California, and is posted on the SacRT website.

This meeting of the Sacramento Regional Transit District is recorded with closed captioning. The recording will be cablecast on Metro Cable Channel 14, the local government affairs channel on the Comcast and DirecTV U-Verse cable systems.
